

MANSLAUGHTER.**The Old Fisherman Found Guilty of It
in the Third Degree—The Motion for
a New Trial.**

The verdict in the case of Mike Raemer, charged with the murder of William Sicking, was read yesterday morning in the Criminal Court, it having taken the jury all night to find it. The verdict declared the old gentleman guilty of manslaughter in the third degree, and assessed his punishment at three months in the City Jail, and fined him \$100. This is the highest sentence allowed by law. Weather-beaten old Mike seemed to think it might have been a good deal worse, and did not appear to feel very bad about it. He wanted to know of his counsel if he could not take his imprisonment in the fall, as he said he would lose a big pile of money if he was locked up now and missed the spring fishing. He hasn't missed a fishing on his accustomed place since '49. Messrs. Harris and Joy, his attorneys, yesterday morning filed a motion for a new trial, having discovered additional evidence for defendant. Judge Jones reserved his decision on the motion, and in the meantime Raemer is enjoying the sweets of liberty on bail.
